## “AML stem cells selectively escape NK cell immune surveillance”

### Professor Dr. Claudia Lengerke

Claudia Lengerke is Professor and Vice-Dean of the Medical Faculty of Tübingen and Director of the Department of Hematology, Oncology, Clinical Immunology and Rheumatology at the University Hospital Tübingen, Germany. She studied Medicine and received her MD in 2001 from the University of Tübingen, Germany, and completed her training in Internal Medicine, Hematology & Oncology at the University Hospital Tübingen. Between 2004 and 2007 she was a research fellow at Harvard University and investigated stem cells, pluripotency and developmental hematopoiesis. After several years as junior research group leader and attending physician at the University Hospital Tübingen, she was for seven years attending physician and Professor for Hematology and Stem Cell Research at the University Hospital and the University of Basel. In May 2020 she joined the University at the University Hospital Tübingen for the current position.

The research activities of Claudia Lengerke focus on the investigation of stem cells and stemness-related mechanisms in hematopoiesis, leukemia and other types of cancer. As a physician-scientist, Claudia Lengerke is especially interested in translating knowledge obtained from basic research into novel therapeutic strategies for patients. As Vice Dean at the Medical Faculty, she actively engages in the promotion of clinical translational and of physician-scientist careers.
